e-fellows.net is the first company to award an online scholarship in Europe to the most talented and successful students. The objective of this private sector initiative is to cultivate these talents by offering them comprehensive Internet research possibilities and services as well as to create a unique network for their studies and career.

e-fellows.net was founded in the spring of 2000 by Deutsche Telekom, the Georg von Holtzbrinck publishing group, and McKinsey & Company. Online scholarship

The first online scholarship in Europe is the core element of e-fellows.net. Undergraduate, postgraduate, and PhD students can apply for this on the www.e-fellows.net webpage. e-fellows.net provides its scholars with the following services:

- Networking and knowledge exchange among 20,000 scholars and 19,000 alumni with the e-fellows.net community and City Groups
- Possibility of researching databases and publications free of charge (e.g., beck-online, EBSCO Business Source Premier, juris, Nature)
- Subsidies to Deutsche Telekom internet and mobile packages
- Personal contacts to the business world based on the mentoring program
- Participation in exclusive events and workshops
- Internships, diploma theses, and job offers

The online scholarship is aimed mainly at those studying law, business/economics, natural sciences, and engineering. In the case of other disciplines, we expect students to demonstrate a high level of interest in business topics (e.g., through internships or minor subjects studied). To be accepted into the scholarship program, all applicants have to have very good academic achievements, internships, and stays abroad as well as be committed to extra-curricular activities.

The initial scholarship period is one year. However, it is possible to extend this until completion of studies. e-fellows.net offers scholars access to attractive programs run by partner companies.
