## ADMISSION

Applicants for admission to the LLM programs must present evidence of one of the following:

- Graduation from a school of law in a foreign country whose educational authority has authorized that school to issue degrees in law; OR
- Graduation from a school of law approved by the American Bar Association; OR
- Admission to the Bar of a state in the United States or overseas.

## DEADLINE

We are currently accepting and reviewing applications for Fall and Spring. **The priority application deadline for Fall is March 30 and for Spring admission is October 30.** After the priority deadline, we will continue to accept and review applications on a rolling basis.

## LLM APPLICATION CHECKLIST

- Complete our Online Application or LSAC Application.
- Submit the following documents:
  - Curriculum vitae (résumé);
  - Statement of Interest;
  - Original official transcripts from colleges, universities, and graduate or professional schools attended, including current law school transcript
- One or more letters of reference, preferably from law school professors or legal employers;
- For non-native English speakers, proof of English proficiency:
  - Receipt of an undergraduate or graduate degree from an English language institution; OR
  - Multi-year employment in a position in which English is the primary language of communication; OR
  - A minimum test score of the following: TOEFL 88; IELTS 6.5; Duolingo 120; or Cambridge C1.
